Anyone that wants to come in early or stay later has to make reservations through me to get the group rate. It is \$32 Sun. through Thurs. and \$42 Fri. and Sat. Check in is at 2:00. If you come in before 2:00 there is a \$10 early arrival fee. Check out is 12 noon. There is a \$10 fee if you check out after 12. There is a \$5 per dog fee for up to 7 days. We have to pay \$50 for the club house which will be divide among the coaches. I will have to assign the spaces in advance because they want a list of who is coming and which space they will be in. **There is a \$10 per site fee for any**

cancellation within 30 days of check in. Any cancellation within 72 hours will be charged the full amount of all nights booked. We also have a \$10 cash deposit for the clubhouse key and a \$25 cash cleaning deposit. Both are refundable.

CHECK IN TIME - Check in time is 1PM. During the busy March Wildflower season, we are unable to accommodate early checks.

In addition we have information about a nearby golf, off-road tours, recreation activities, and we are located just minutes away from the Anza Borrego Desert State Park Visitor's center.

Location of the resort is about 8 miles north of Pahrump on Highway 160. The cost per night will be \$20 and some cents, and we will charge a small rally fee. We haven't finalized everything, but the park has a full service restaurant and they serve great breakfasts and lunches. They have a large convention center if we decide on dinners (they serve dinners for \$12-\$15 a person depending on what you want, the higher cost is for prime rib dinner). There are a number of smaller rooms where we could set up for card playing and games. There is a beautiful pool area with area around for seating for dinner if weather permits. They have an exercise room with great facilities in the respective rest rooms with Jacuzzi, steam room, sauna and everything is clean, clean, clean. There is also a six lane bowling

area and shuffleboard courts. The staff is very cooperative and would be willing to set up a slot tournament and they have an agreement with the Nugget in town to allow us to have two-for-one buffets on weekends (which normally are only during weekdays). We have reserved 50 spots. If we need more, they have plenty of beautiful spots, a lot of them with Tiki huts and gas barbecues.
